

Attention Lake Trout Anglers

2010 Squeers Lake Controlled Winter Fishery

The Ministry of Natural Resources (MNR) is looking for anglers to participate in the 2010 Squeers Lake Controlled Winter Fishery.

This is the 26 th. year of a study to determine the maximum harvest that lakes similar to Squeers Lake can sustain without affecting the lake trout population's ability to replace itself.

The fishery will run from **Saturday March 20 to Sunday March 28, 2010.**

Anglers interested in participating in the study can apply to fish one of the nine days by submitting a completed application form and sending it to:

Applications will be chosen by a lottery draw. All selected applicants will be notified by mail after **Monday, March 1, 2010.**

Regulations:

- 1) **The limit for lake trout will remain at 5 fish per angler**
- 2) **Substitutions will be allowed as long as one of the original applicants attends**
- 3) **No angling license required**
