Beretta, which now owns both SAKO and Tikka, has just introduced the new SAKO A7, based on the SAKO 75. It retains many of the better features of the SAKO 75, including adjustable trigger (2.2 lb. minimum pull), three-lug bolt with 70° throw, and ergonomic stock. The A7 offers a new 3-round detachable magazine, with an improved latching mechanism drawn from the SAKO 85.

Each A7 is test-fired at the factory and must shoot a five-shot group that measures an inch or less at 100 yards before it leaves.

This rifle features a fully free-floating, match-grade, hammer-forged stainless barrel. It has a machined, two-piece bolt with three locking lugs and a short, ultrasmooth, 70° bolt lift. There's a two-position safety with a separate bolt release. The forged-steel round-top receiver has Weaver scope-mount bases installed. Adjust the single-stage trigger to break between 2 and 4 lbs. Weatherproof synthetic stock with a rubber recoil pad and sling swivel mounts. The detachable synthetic magazine has steel feed lips.
