Possible Flies (pick one or submit a favourite of your own)

- Eggs and Roe: (Blood dot, Micro-Egg, Glow, Estaz, Babine, Milt)
- Marabou and Spey:

- Nymphs: Stone fly, Shrimp, Hare's Ear, Caddis

4. Submit a finished fly. We will photograph the fly (for consistency on the website)
